Below are some of the jobs a farmer has to do to look after the animals on the farm. Can you draw a picture of each job.

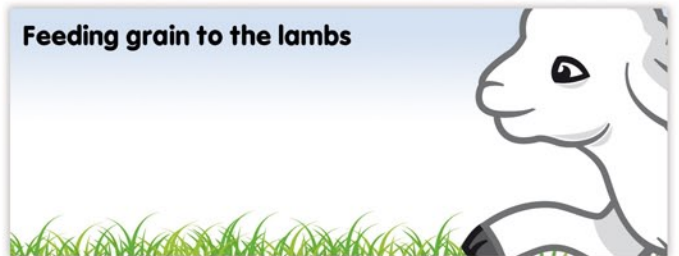
Cleaning the pig pen
